

PACKING LIST

ITEMS YOUR CHILD WILL NEED TO BRING TO PILGRIM CAMP 2025!

Unless they say optional, they are a must have!!

BEDDING:

- Bottom sheet to cover the mattress
- Top sheet to use as a cover if it is hot (Optional)
- Sleeping bag and/or blankets
- Pillow(s)
- Your favorite stuffed toy or doll to keep you company at night (Optional)

TOILETRIES:

- Hair brush/comb
- Toothbrush
- Toothpaste
- Plastic drinking cup (optional)
- Small bag or caddy to carry toiletries to shower
- 2 towels (1 for bath, 1 for swim)
- Wash cloth (optional)
- Shampoo
- Conditioner
- Soap/ body wash in a plastic container

CLOTHING: We suggest that you pack your child's clothing in prepared gallon sized ziplock bags that are labeled for each day, with a minimum of 1 extra set. It would also be helpful if you label your child's clothes with their name on it to make it easier for your child to keep track of their clothing in the cabin sharing a room with other campers.

- 6-8 T-shirts
- 7-9 Pairs of shorts
- 2-3 Pairs of jeans/ long pants
- 1-2 Sweatshirts
- 1-2 Long sleeved shirt
- 1-2 Sets of pajamas

- 7-9 Sets of socks and underwear/bring extra - there will be times when you will get wet
- 1 Pair of sneakers (minimally)
- 1 Pair of water shoes with backs (crocs, an extra pair of sneakers or other water sandals are a great option)
- 1 Pair of flip flops (optional - for showers and pool areas ONLY)
- 2-3 Bathing suits (no bikinis, please), cover-up to be worn to pool
- 1 raincoat/poncho with hood
- Umbrella (optional)
- 1 WHITE T- SHIRT to use for an activity
- Extra clothes!! We like to play with water!!

ADDITIONAL ITEMS:

- Sunscreen
- Insect repellent (lotion or wipes, no aerosols please...practice at home how to use these)
- A WATER BOTTLE with your child's name on it
- A large (plastic) bag for dirty and wet clothes
- Flashlight and/or night light (optional)
- Hat
- Sunglasses for looking cool (optional)
- A picture of your family to keep by your bunk (optional)
- A couple of your favorite books to read, writing paper, puzzle books and pens to be used during quiet time. You might want to include an envelope or 2 already addressed to you with a stamp, so your child can send you a letter.
- A ball to play with other campers..., football, soccer, nerf, ... (optional)
- Squirt gun for water games
- Masks (optional)

As this year the 4th of July falls on the Friday of camp, feel free to send your child with red, white and blue festive gear/ clothes for dressing up on Friday! This is optional, but FUN!

ALL ELECTRONIC TOYS/ DEVICES MUST BE LEFT AT HOME! This includes, but is not limited to, cell phones, tablets, e-readers, Wii switches, and more. Instead, bring books, friendship bracelets, notebooks, coloring books, playing cards or other similar activities.

Your child does not need a cell phone for pictures, we will be taking pictures all week of our activities. Should your child want to take pictures, please send them with a disposable camera or camera that does not have connection capabilities.

Be sure to mark your clothes and other items with your name using permanent marker!
